Evangelization is not always knocking on doors and praying with someone we really don't know and who may not want to pray anyway. **Evangelization can be what some already do.**

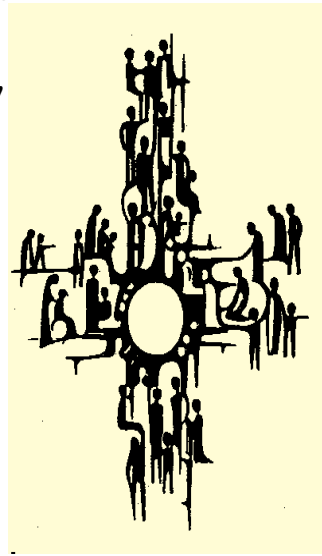

Religious Education teachers, Choir members, piano players, attending daily Mass, Lead the congregation in morning prayer, prepare a meal for an elderly person, adult Bible study, RCIA adult formation, donate to the food shelf, Sacristan (setting up for/cleaning up after Mass), maintenance of the Church buildings, give someone a ride to church, Church secretary /administration.

These we already do, however we need more help.

Church participation always involves personal sacrifice; there is, after all, nearly always something that we would rather be doing.

We always need more help, more evangelization...
